CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

2012 was a year of SWRU consolidation with a couple of firsts being the Tri – State Cup for 15s in field of the National for all States held over the June long weekend between Sydney, NSW Country, and ACT with Brisbane being forced to withdraw due to funding. Those competitions are essential for 15s development and as a guide to the next National coach whom we hope will be appointed in 2012 to prepare for the 2014 WRC in France from early 2013.

The formation of NSW WRU under the lendership of Kerry Chikarovski and with the full support of the NSWRU has opened up many opportunities for necessary sponsorship and Covernment support to increase junior participation for both genders. Such state development will in time flow onto senior clabs and stronger representative teams for both 15s and 7s, although improved communications are necessary between the ARU's HPU and stake holders if both form of 15s and 7s rugby are to prosper.

The inaugural 7s Nationals was successfully conducted in Sydney by the ARU to identify potential offic 7s players, with the playing standard likely to improve further in following years. 7s is an essential fitness aid through the summer months however two competition divisions are preferred to cater for the majority of Women rugby players who are robust 15s developed players and with hopefully realistic competition ontry foos when there is a tournament almost every weekend somewhere during the summer months.


The 15s playing number in Sydney appeared slightly higher in 2012 even with the absence of many clife 7s players who appear exempt from playing essential Club 15s and the skills and passion that flows from Club rugby. With just a six team competition Sydney rugby will struggle to devate itself without a parallel Junior competition and hopefully 2013 will see the development in Schools and Junior clubs. This development will require significant resources with a five year plan to be successful and to return the Sydney Club competition back to ten or twelve teams.

Congratulations must go to Warringals for their success in the 2012 Grand Final with a very close 7 v 3 victory over the undefeated premiers Sydney University The Finals standard are always high.

The fitness level of many playors through the competition was lagging again this year even with reduced playing halves down from fourty to thirty minutes three Clobs still recorded high scores which is little incentive to these lower placed teams. Skills abound so let's hope for an improvement from 2013.

Special thanks must go out to all committee members and again to Mark Green for his continued dedication to the SWRU which has flowed into NSW WRU who are now enjoying his knowledge, skills and support. NSWRU continue to provide full support to Women's rugby and we are looking forward to the flow on success to SWRU from this newly formed association.
